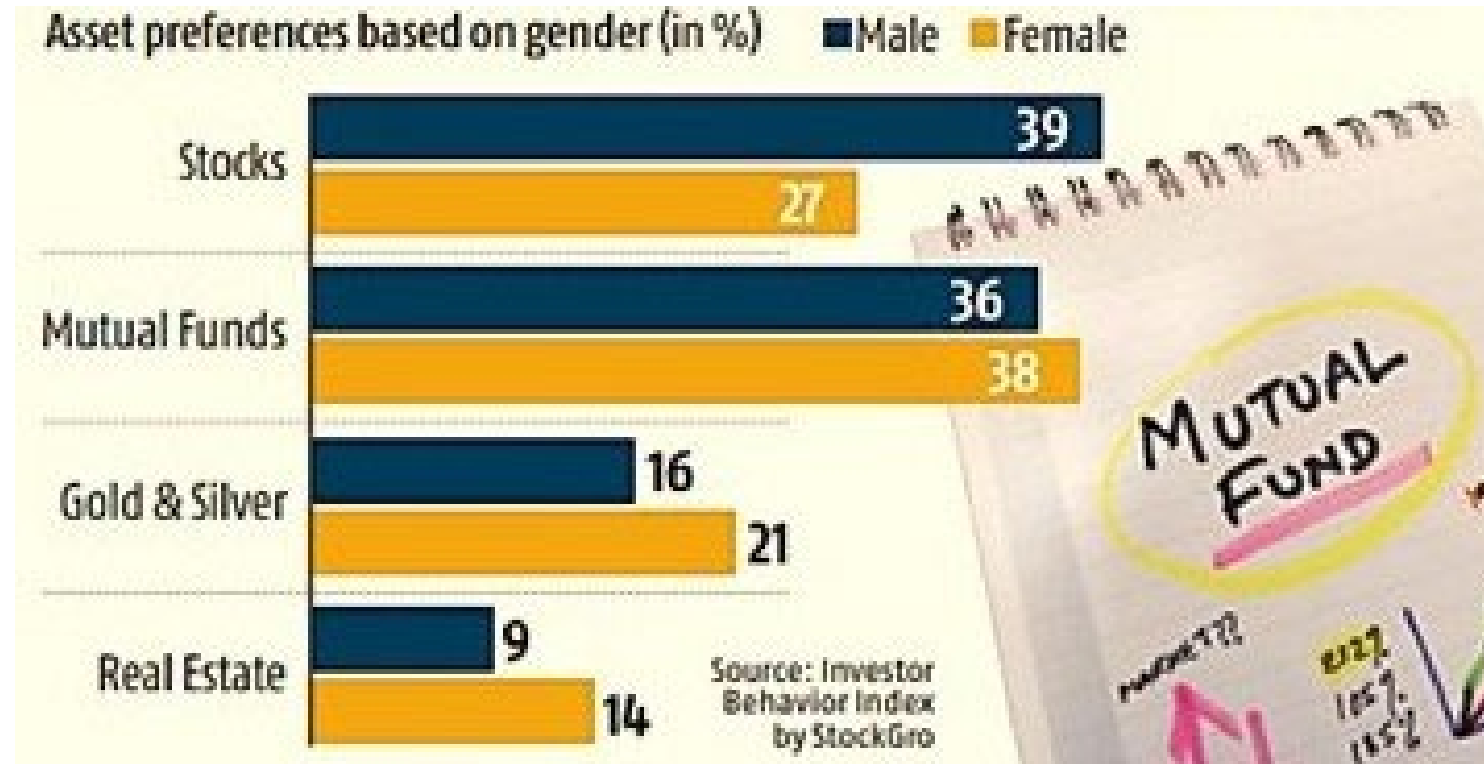
Clean energy in China's in 2024

Clean Energy Tech now contributes 10% to Chinese GDP



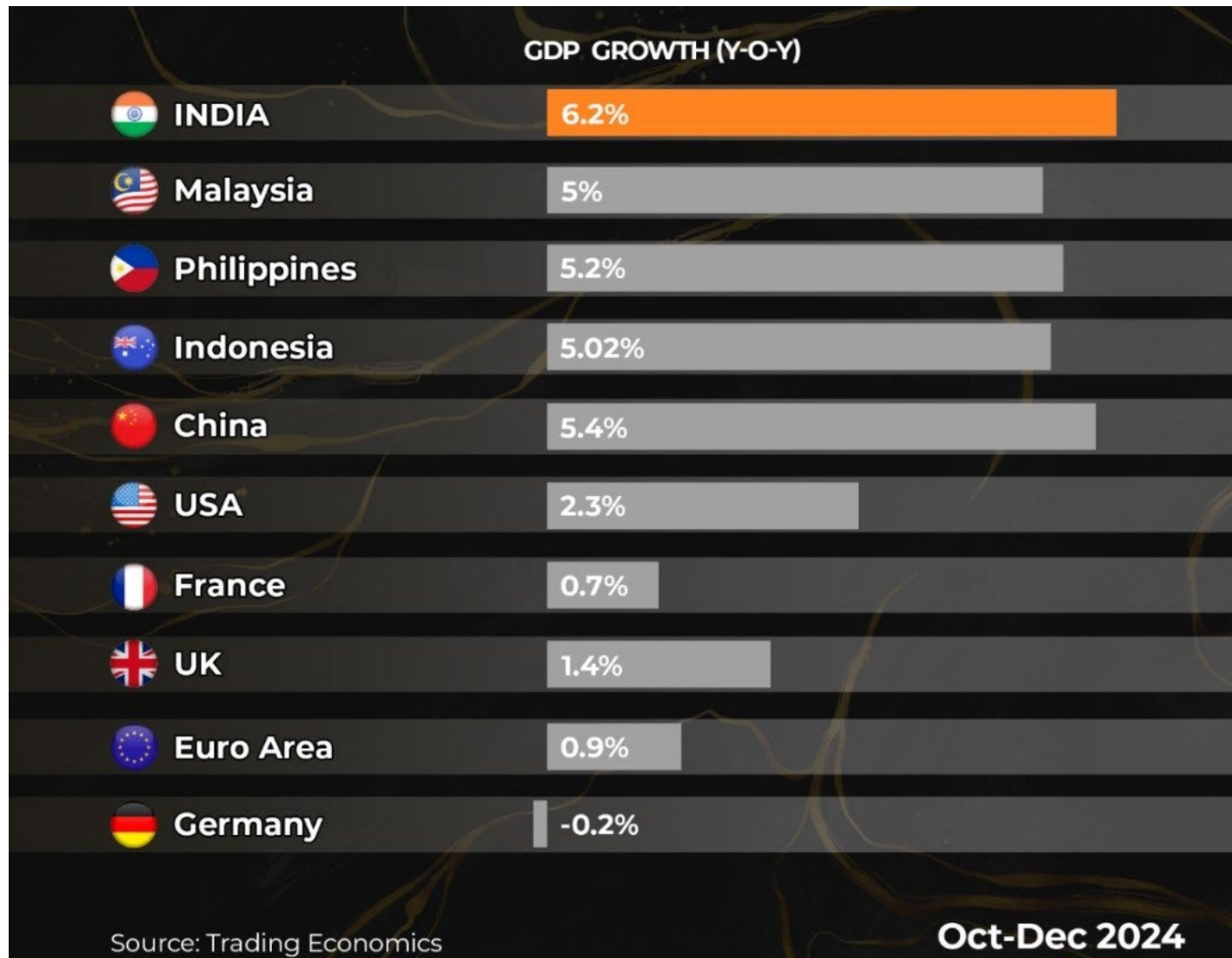
2 Investment preferences based on genders

India has seen a slight slowdown in GDP growth, but continues to be the fastest growing large economy

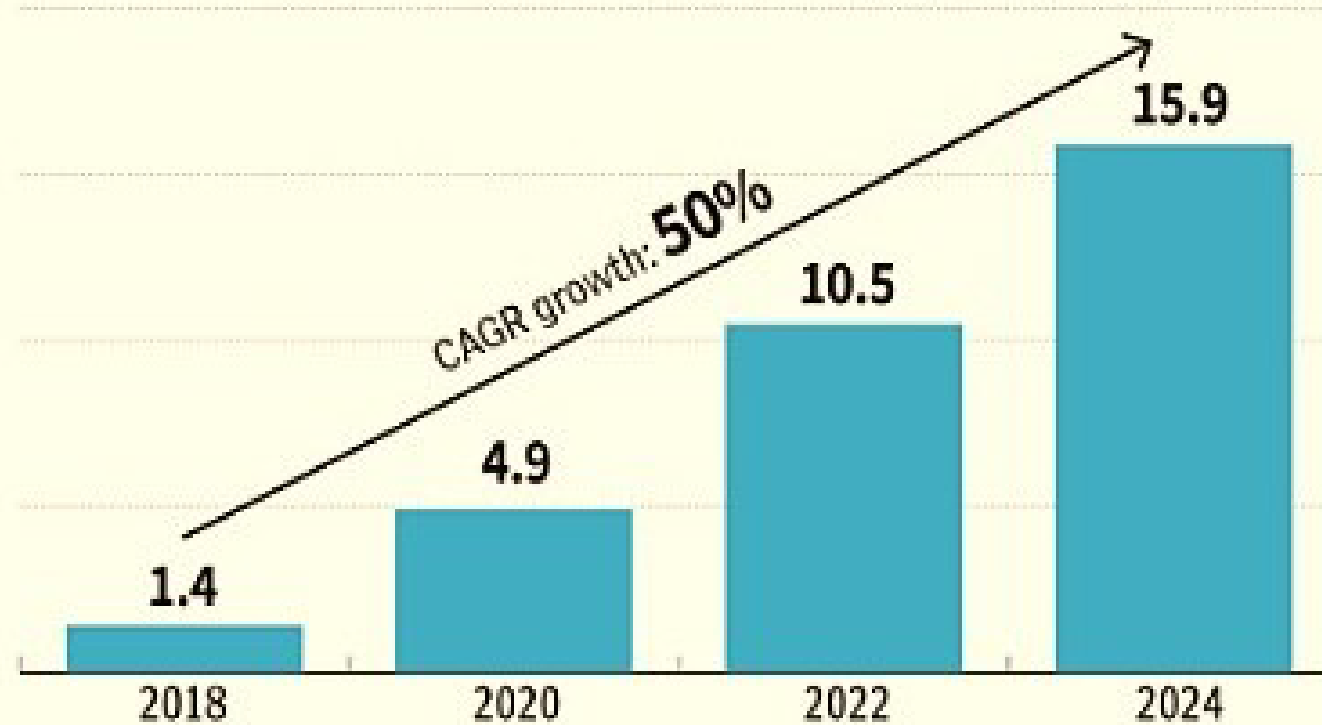


4 Global Lab Grown Diamonds (LGD) supply (in terms of million carats)

2020-2024 (in tonnes)

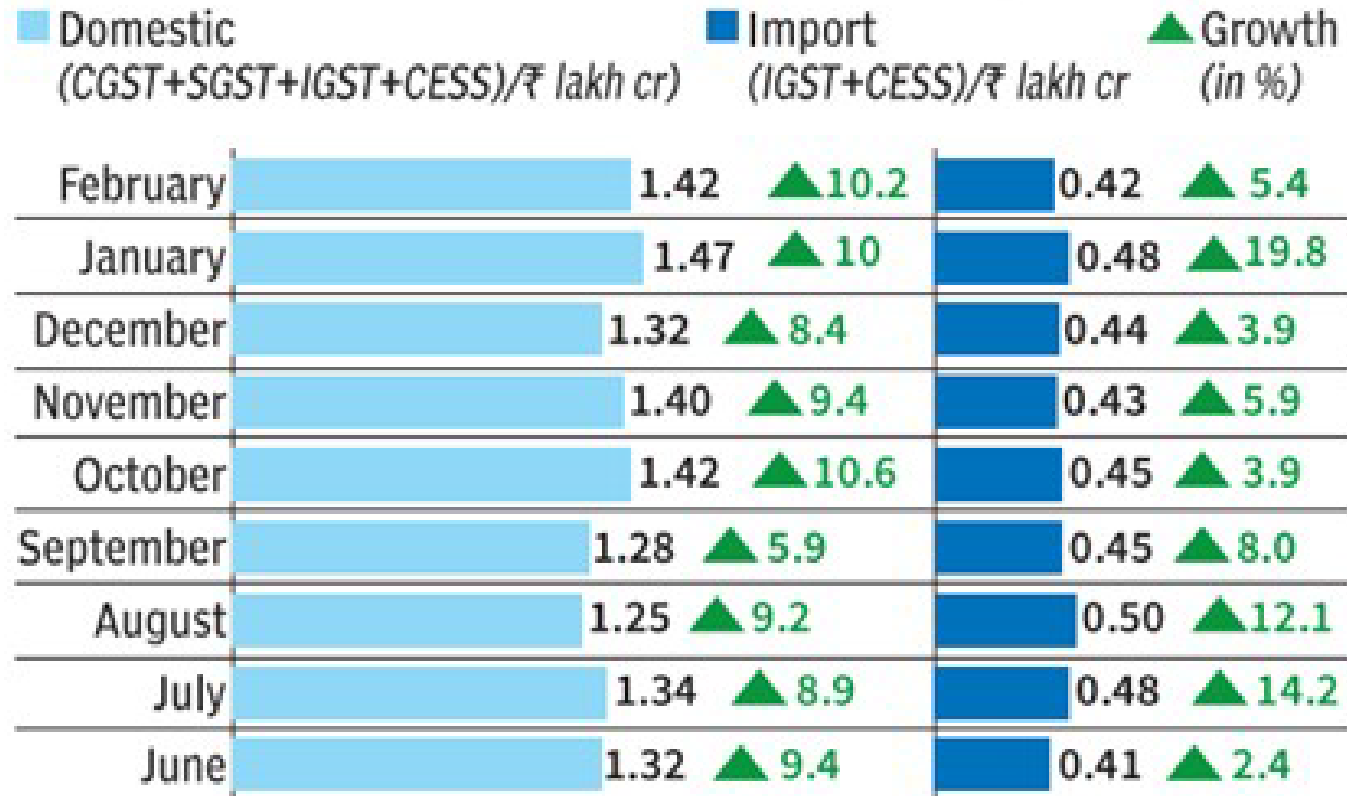

For the first 2 months of CY 2025, domestic GST collections have witnessed a double-digit growth rate on a YoY basis

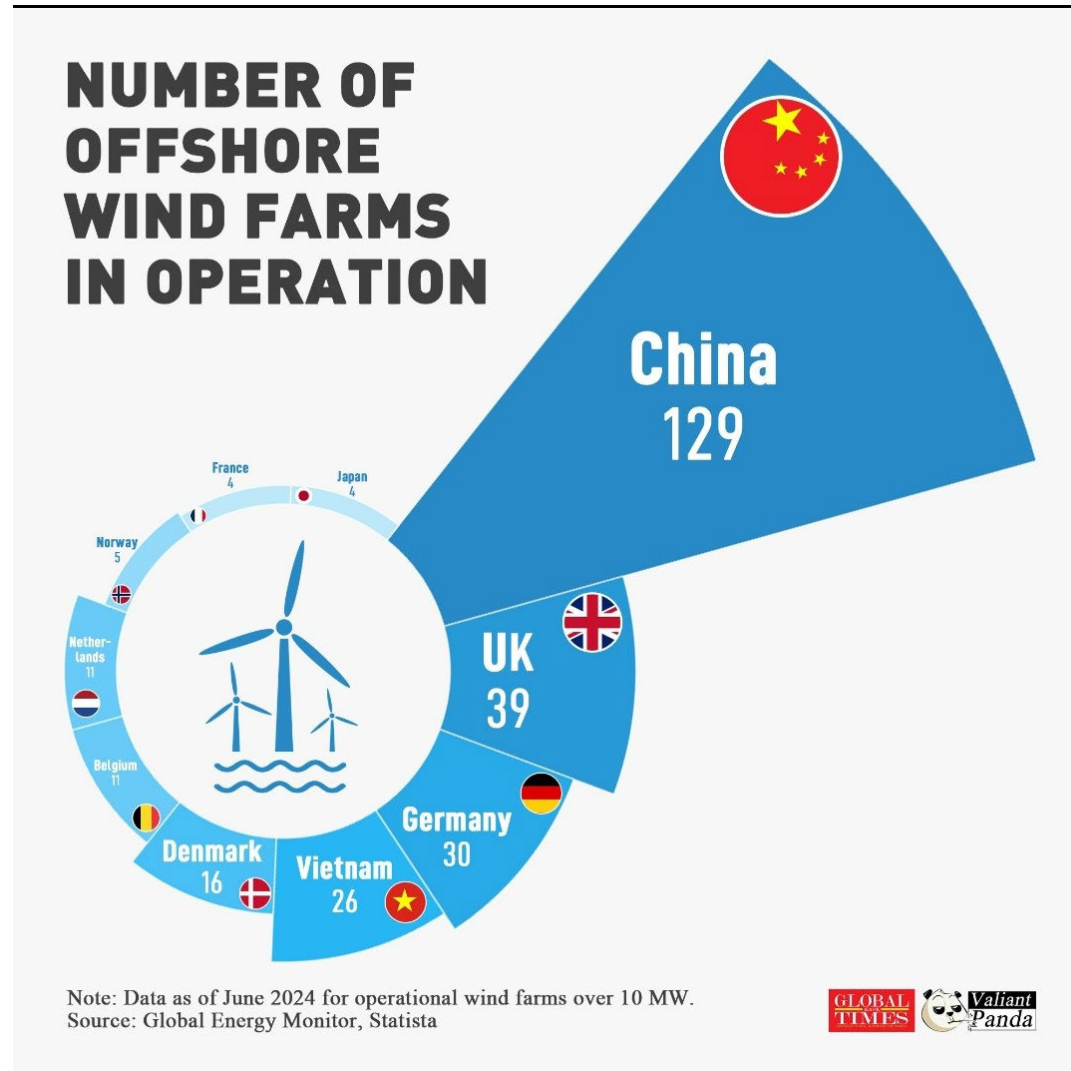
GST collections on the rise *(in 2024-25)*

8 The world's most walkable cities

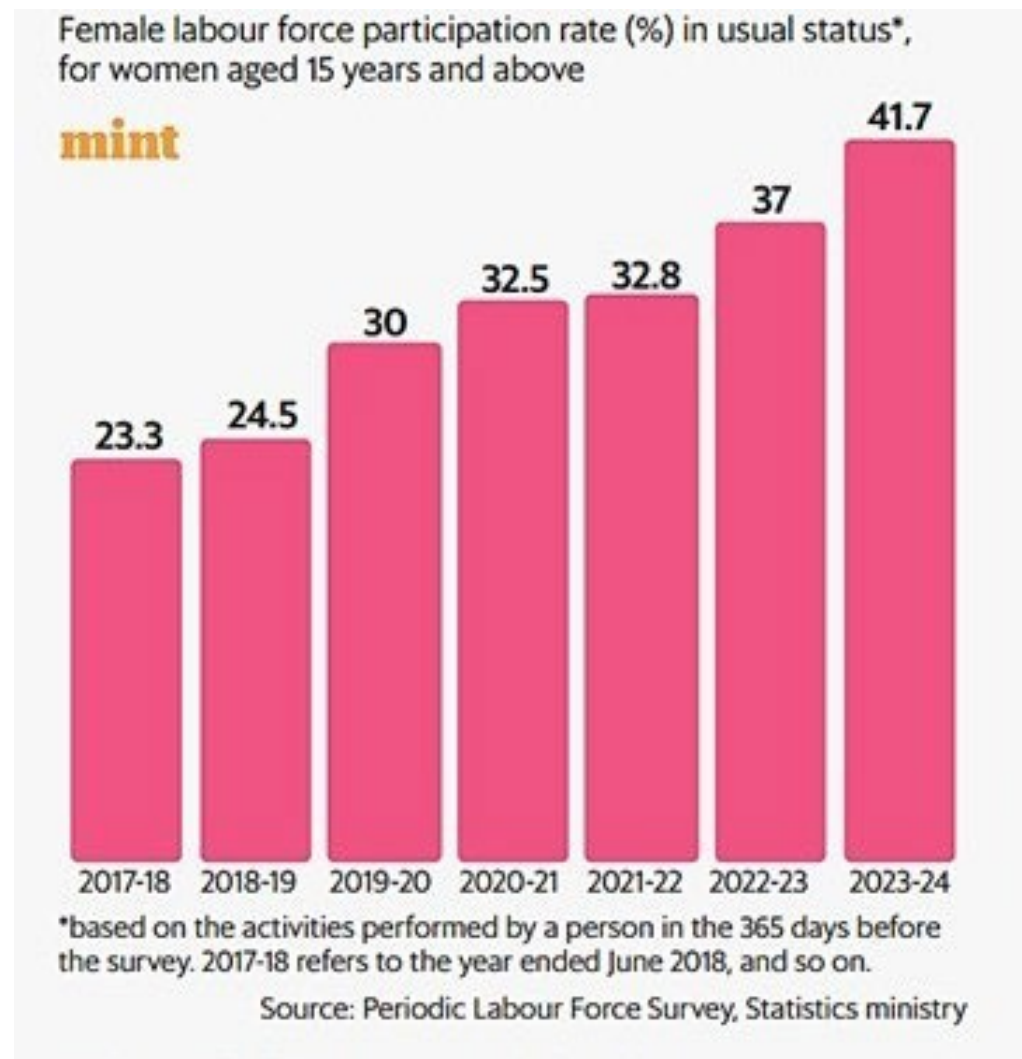
Europe continues to lead with maximum walkable cities

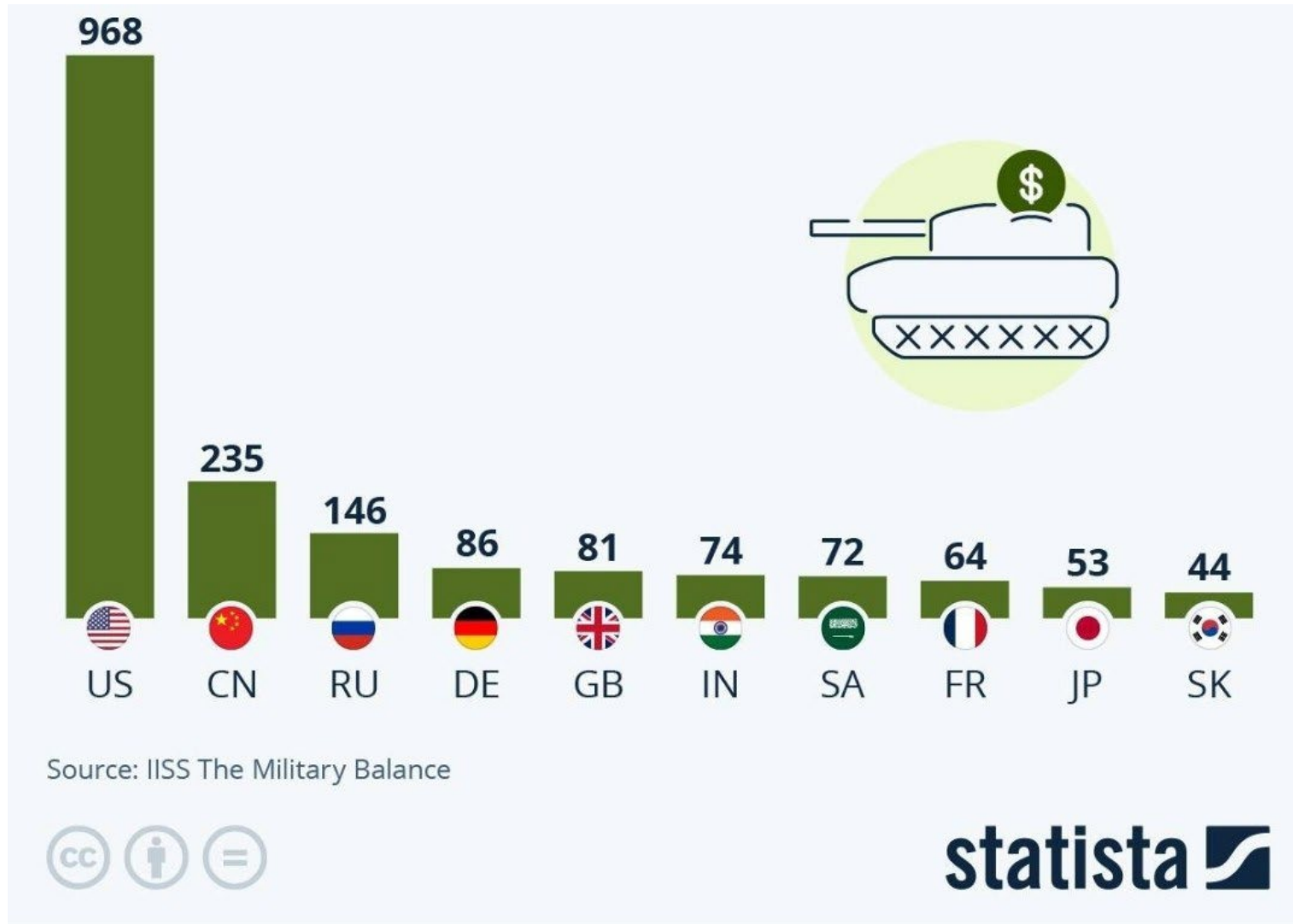
Women's participation in workforce in India
