



US vs China: Eight measures of power

South Korea and India have higher gap in the tariffs levied by them on the US vs tariffs by the US.




3 People older than 60 years in workforce


4 Economies ranked by exposure of exports to the US

Mexico has the highest and Switzerland has the lowest exposure of exports to the US.




5 Gold addition by different countries

China has been most aggressive in adding gold followed by India and Poland.




6 Plastics: how much are we recycling?

Only 9% of the plastics produced is getting recycled.




India GDP grows fastest and doubles over a decade; followed by China, US and Russia. Japan's GDP is flat for 10 years



8 Where are the world's rare earth metals?


China has the highest rare earth metal reserves while Vietnam is the distant second.
