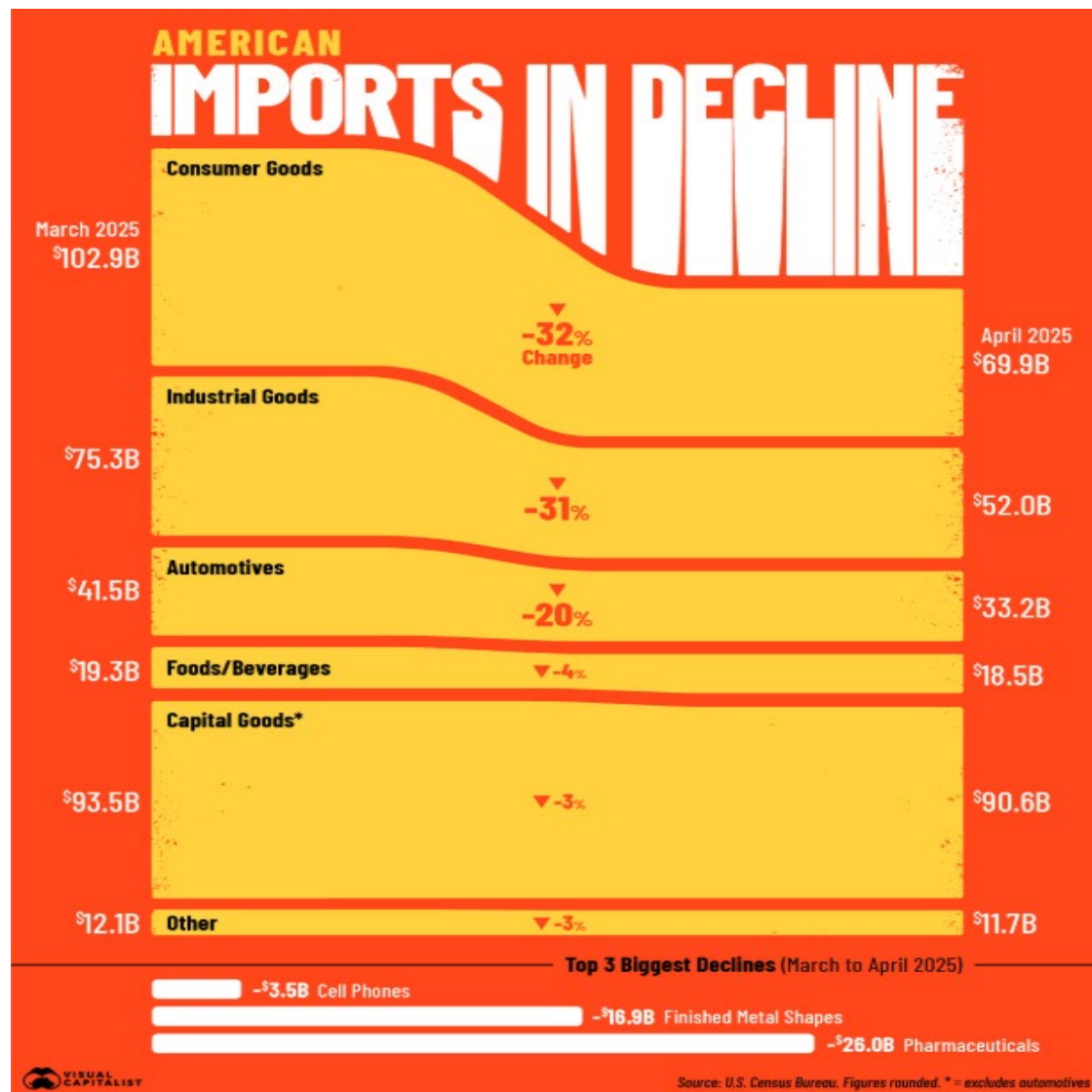

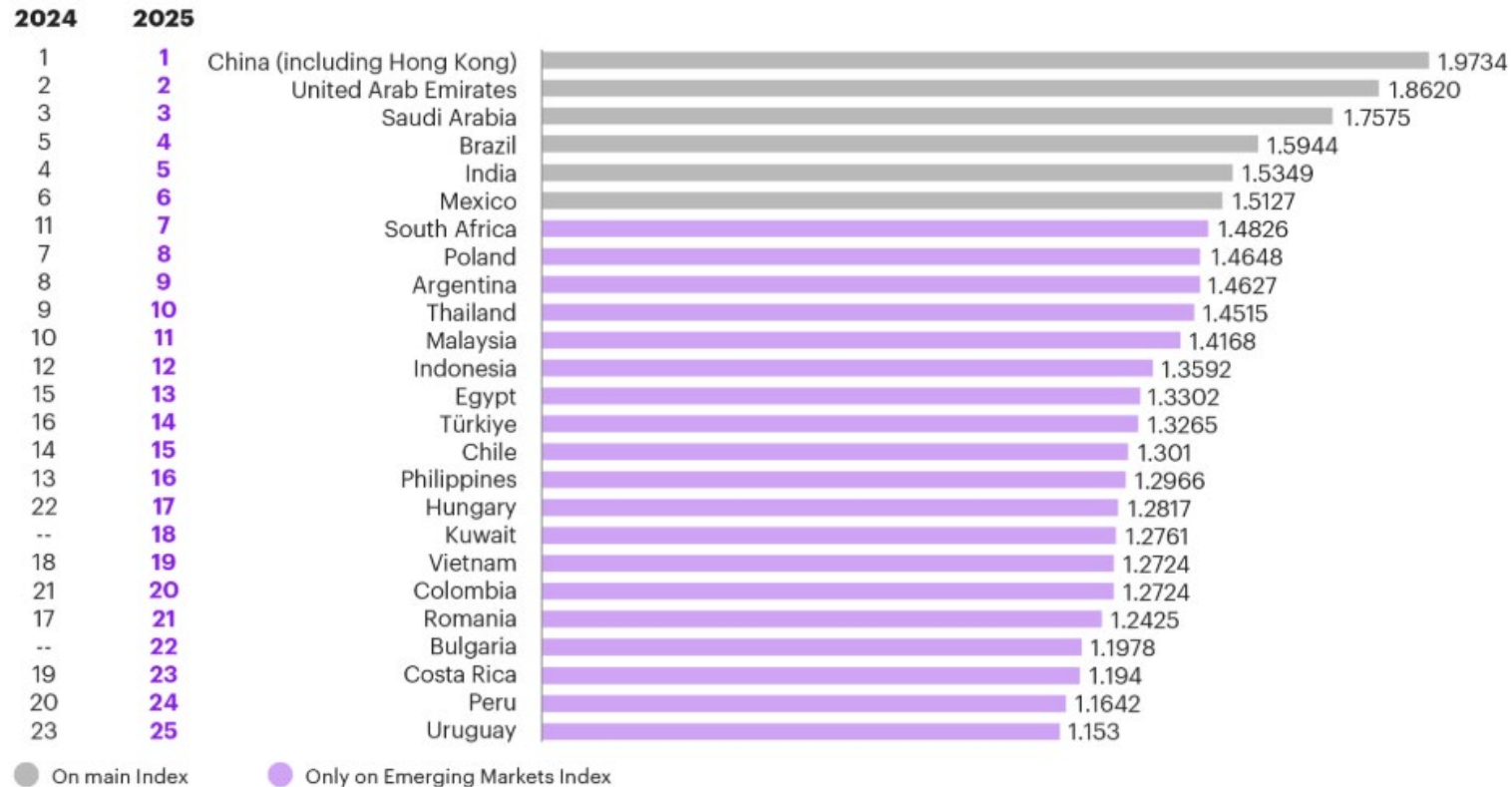

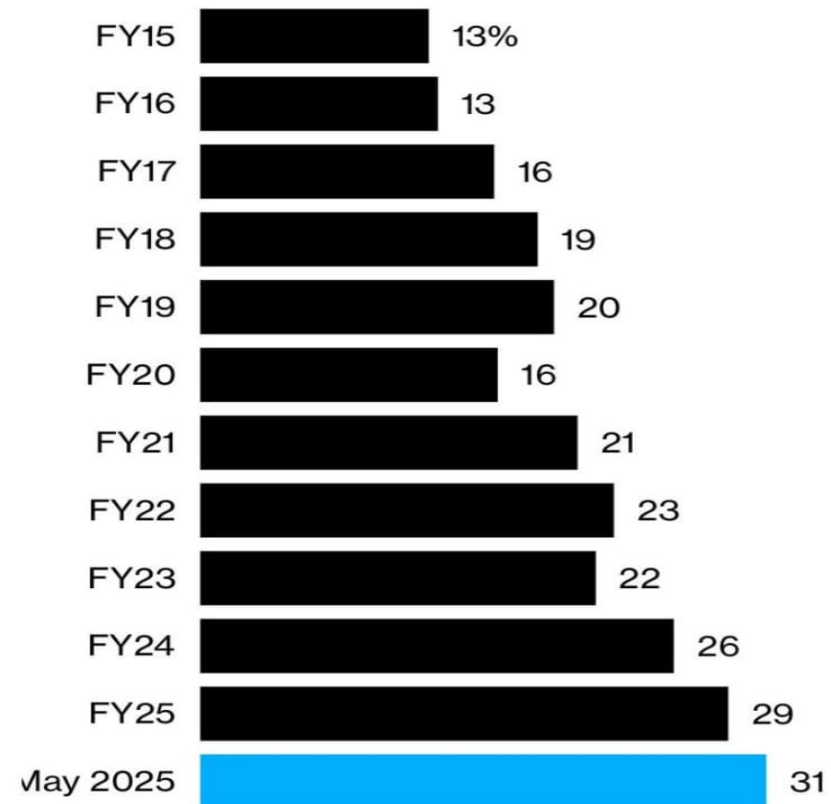

Mutual funds gaining preference; share more than doubles in the last 5 years

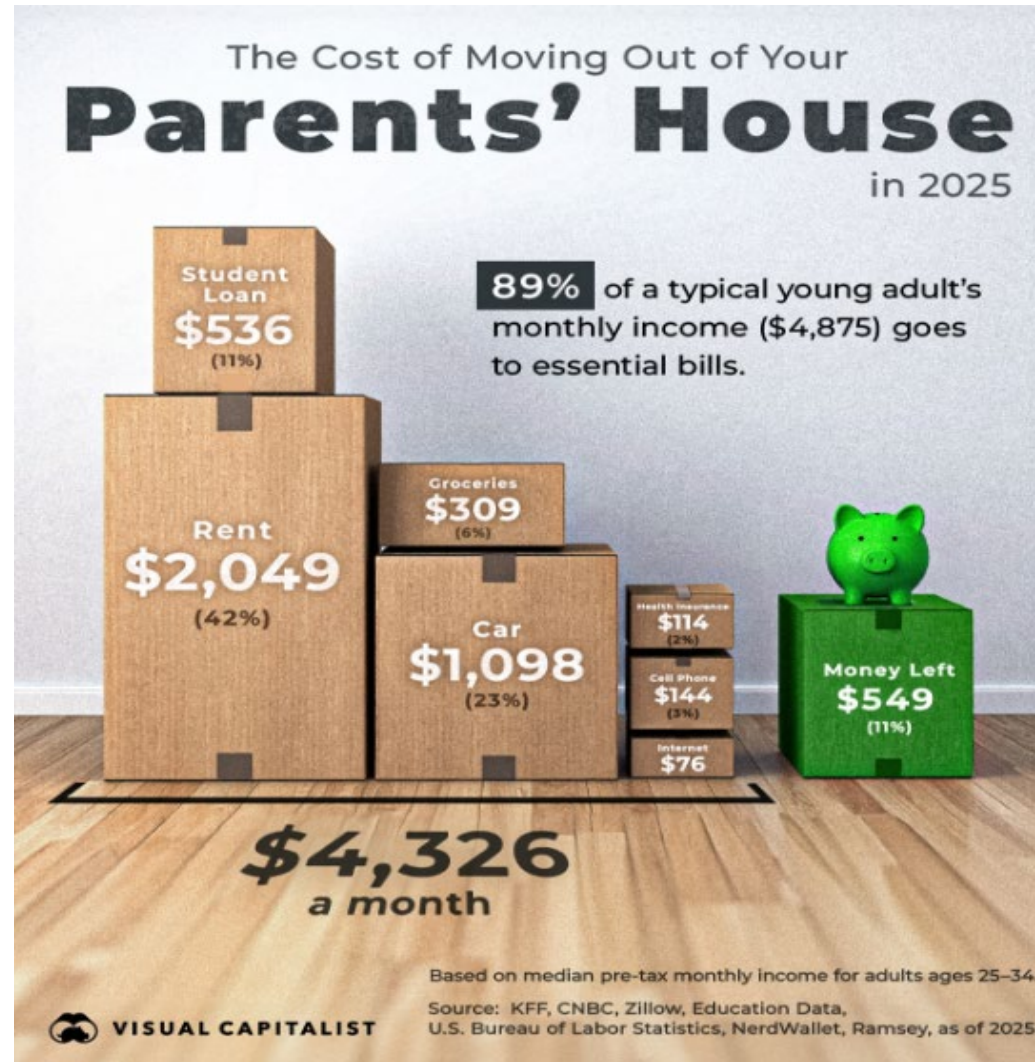
## Mutual Funds Assets Nearly a Third of Bank Deposits

# 5 Global copper refining capacity

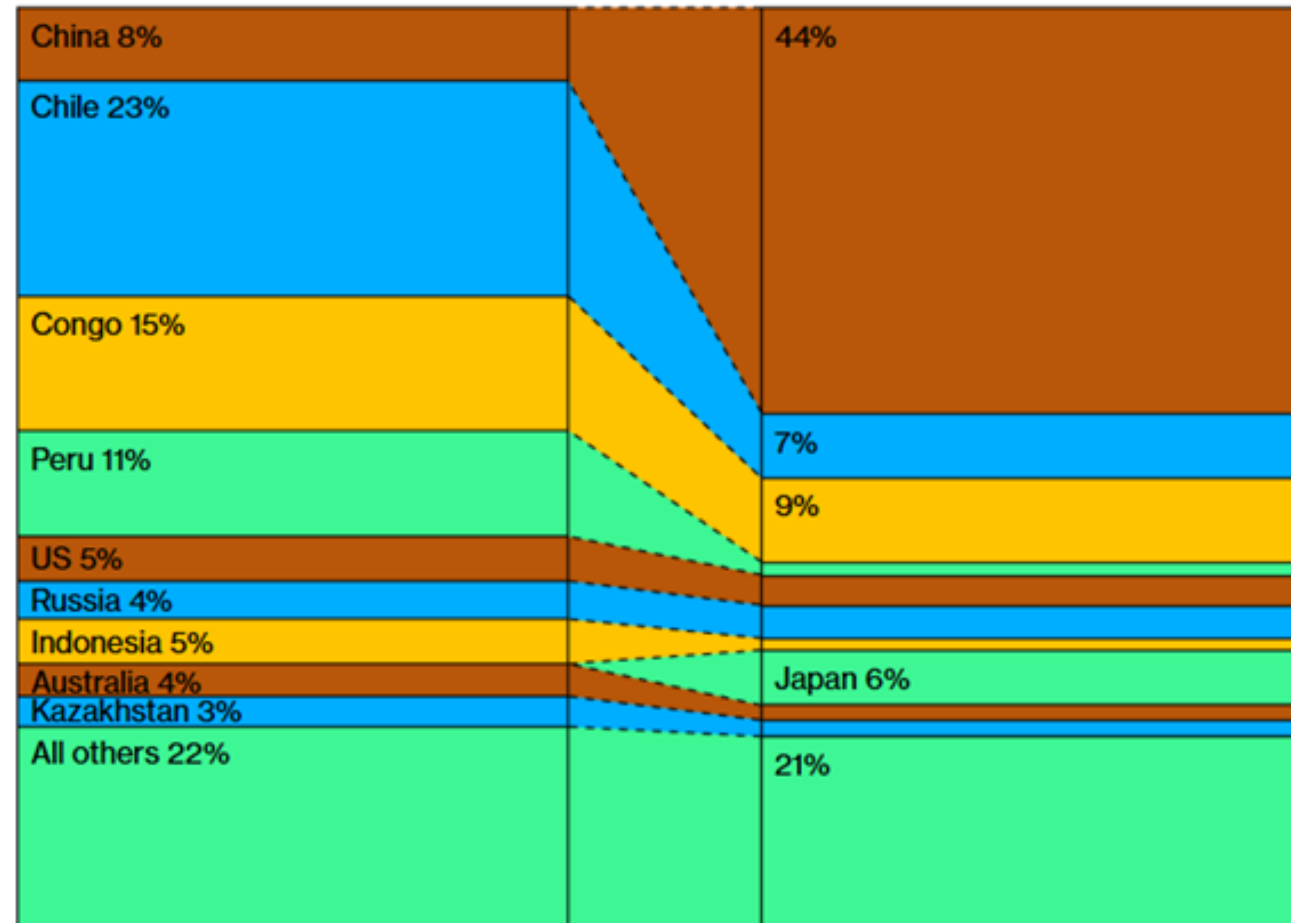
China produces about 13 times more refined copper than the US.

Where copper is produced

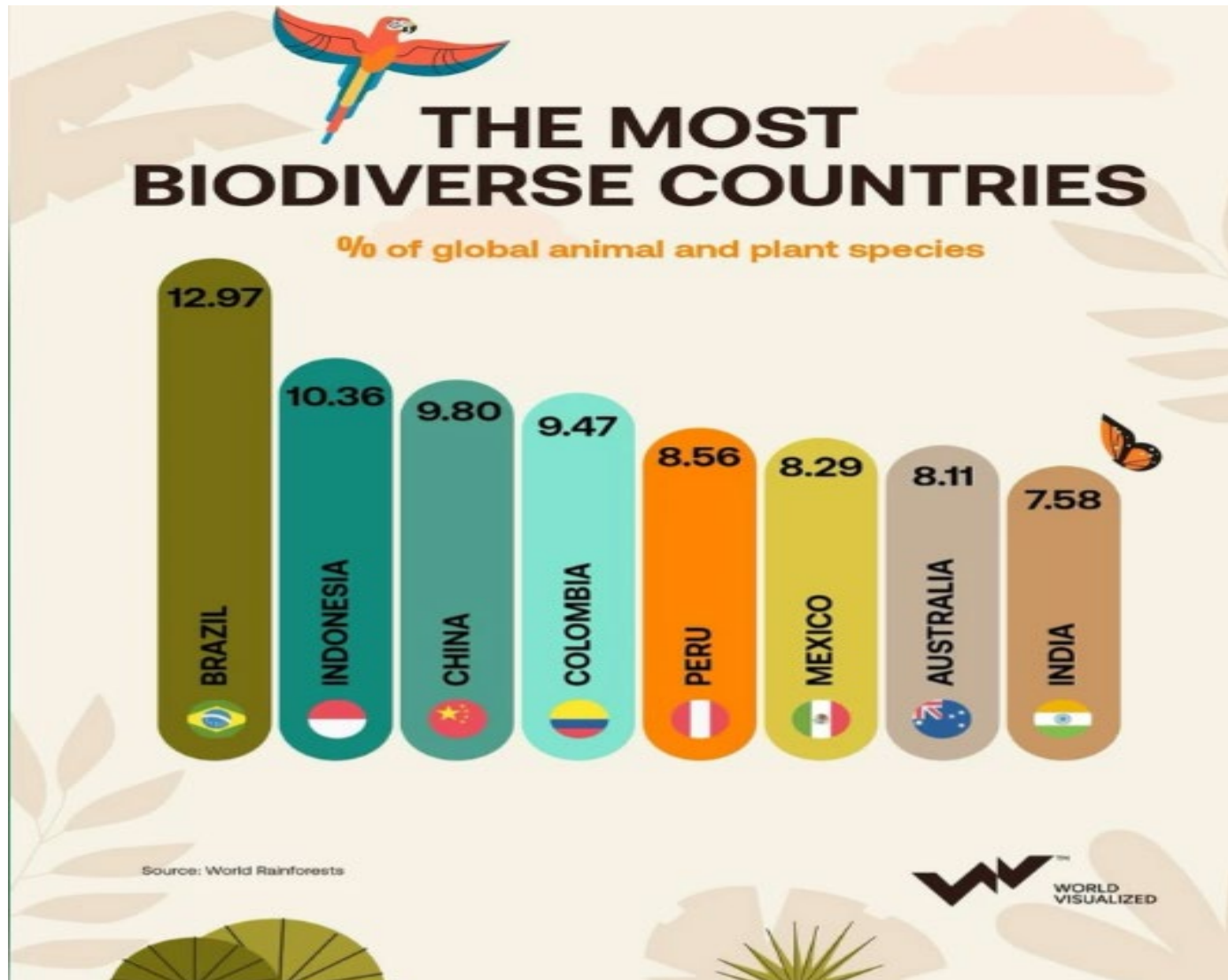
Mine production

Refinery production



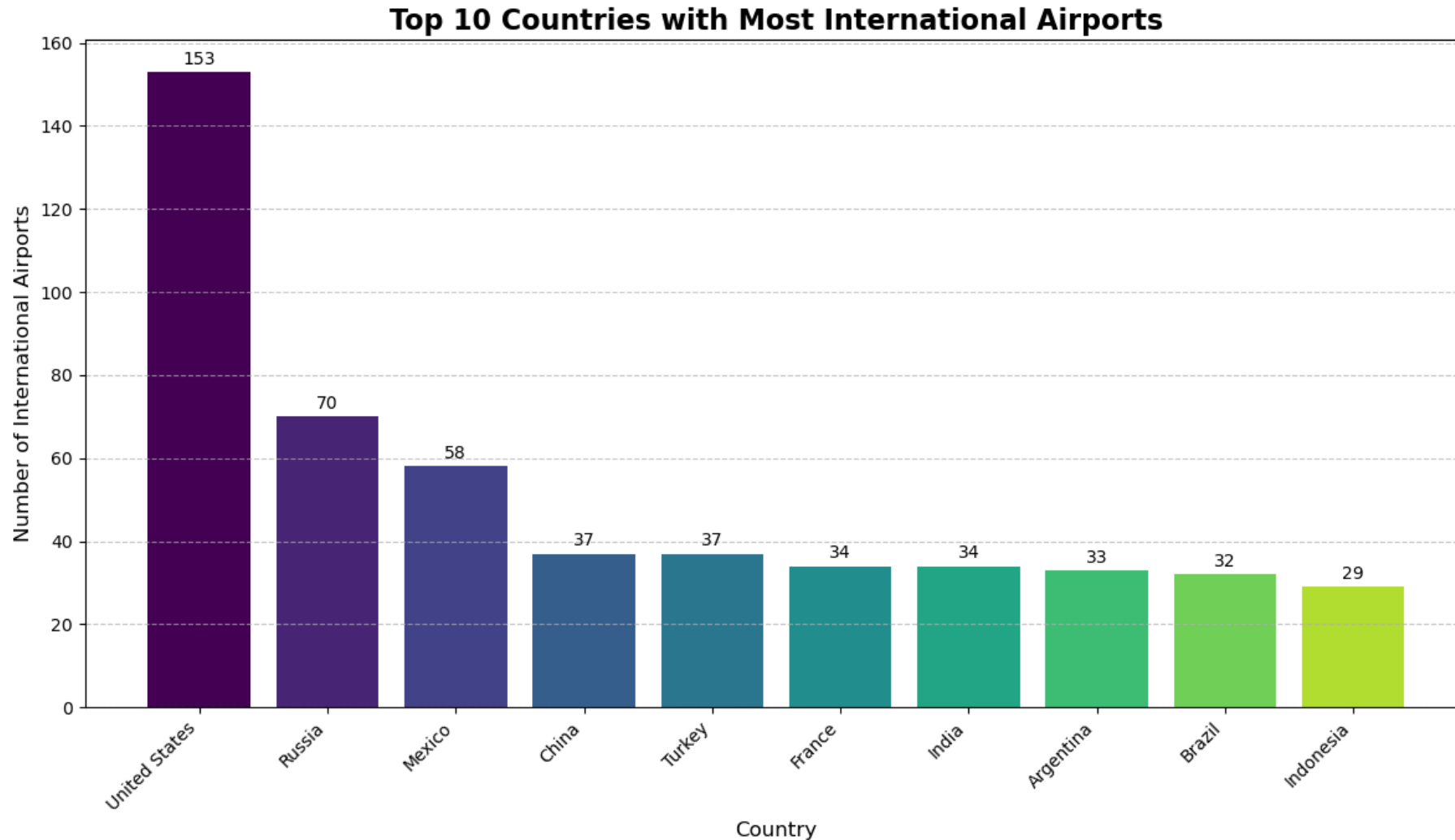
# 6 The most biodiverse countries in the world

# 9 Top 5 Monthly Trade surplus countries in the World, as of May 2025

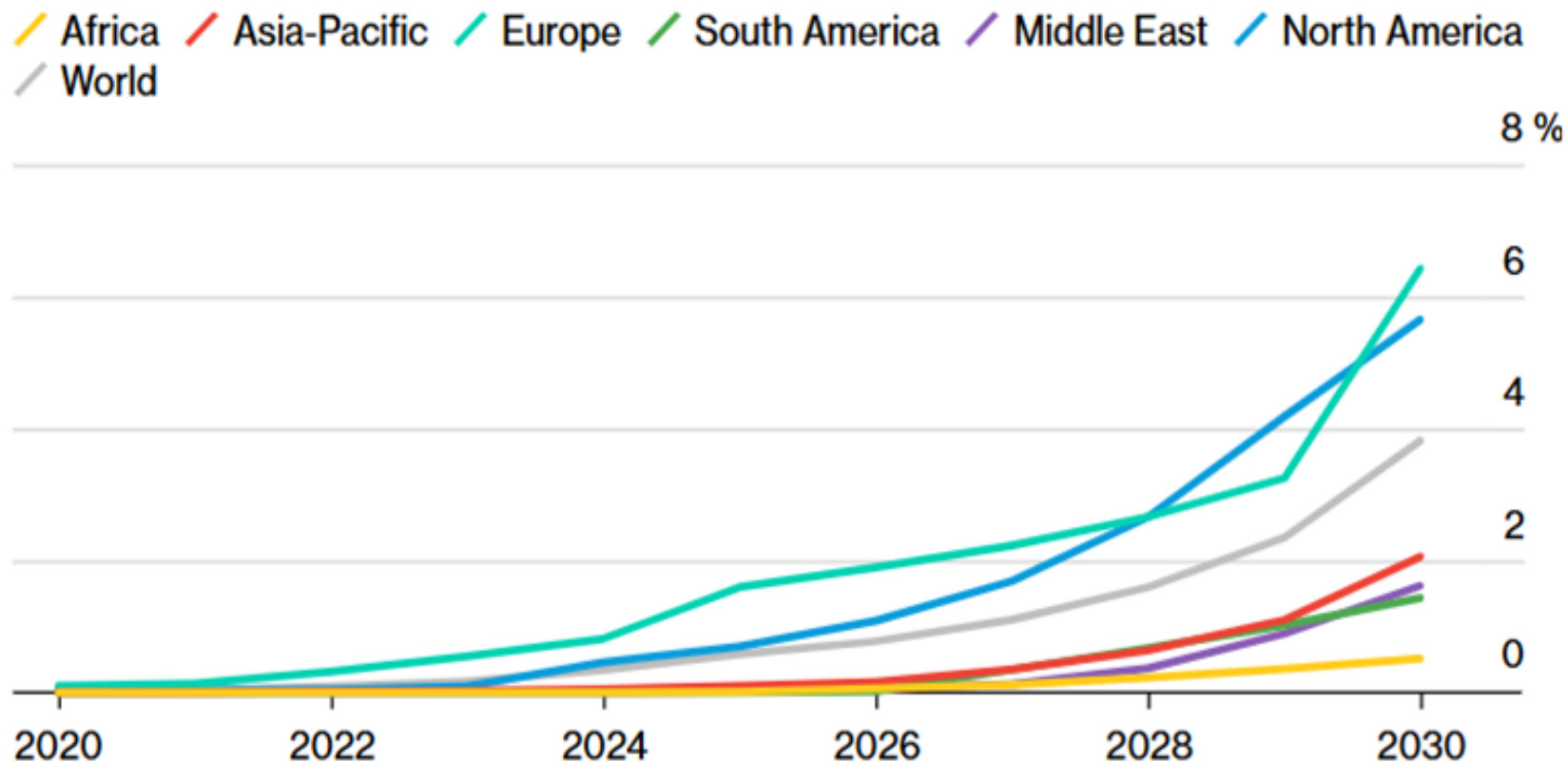
China tops the list with more than \$100bn in trade surplus while Germany is a distant second.
