





NTT global data centres has the largest live and pipeline capacity in MW

GST rate cuts and cheaper food prices led to lower inflation print




4 Copper Prices surge to historical levels

Greece, China and Japan hold over 40% of the world's shipping capacity




6 Indian Rupee Among worst performers in Asia

Foreign outflows from stocks, tariffs weigh on currency


Year-to-date return against the dollar (%)


Share of respondents who live alone by country (in %), India is at the lowest at 4%

China Sees Unprecedented Slump in Investment


The scale of the slowdown in recent months was the biggest outside of 2020
